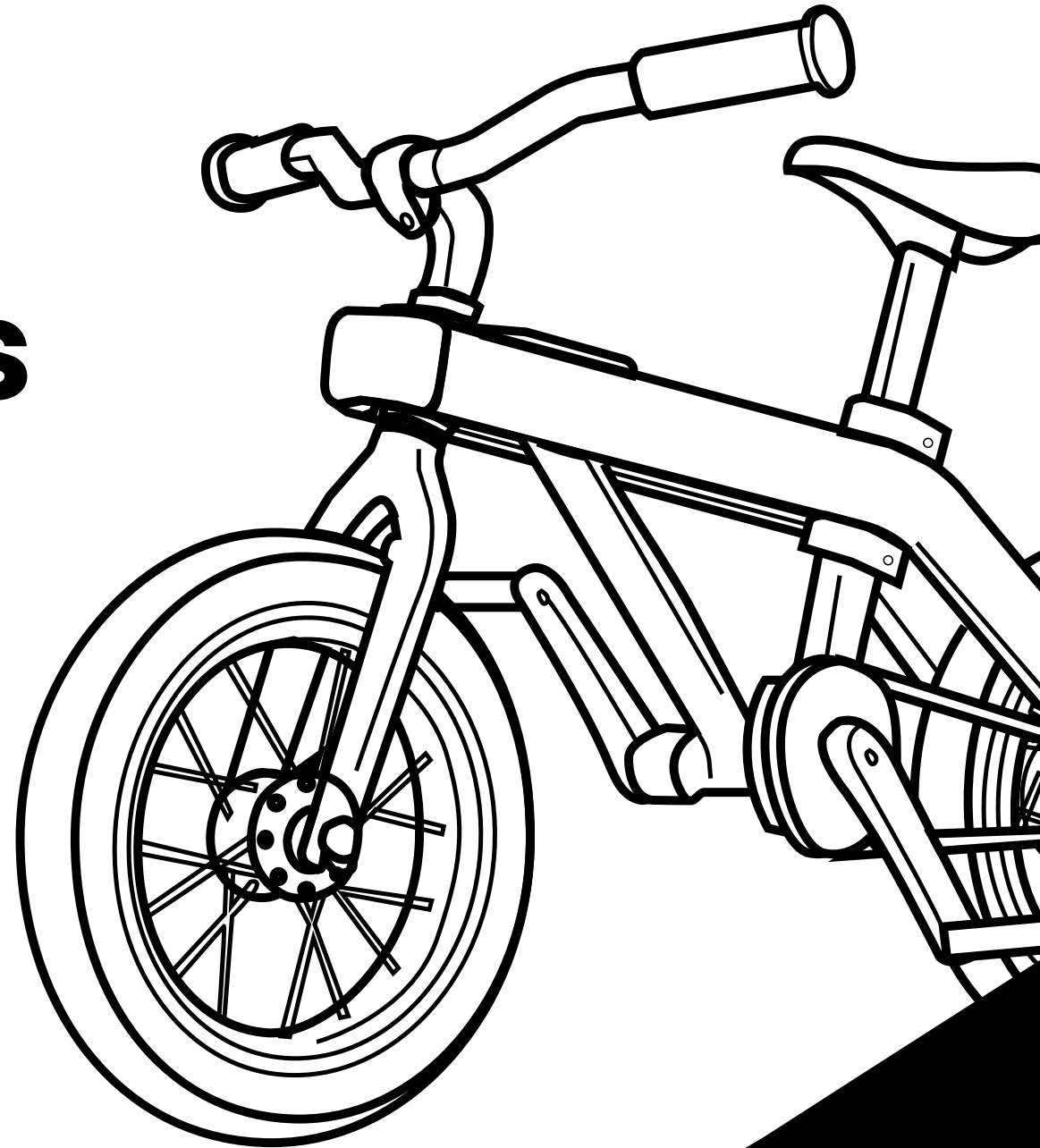

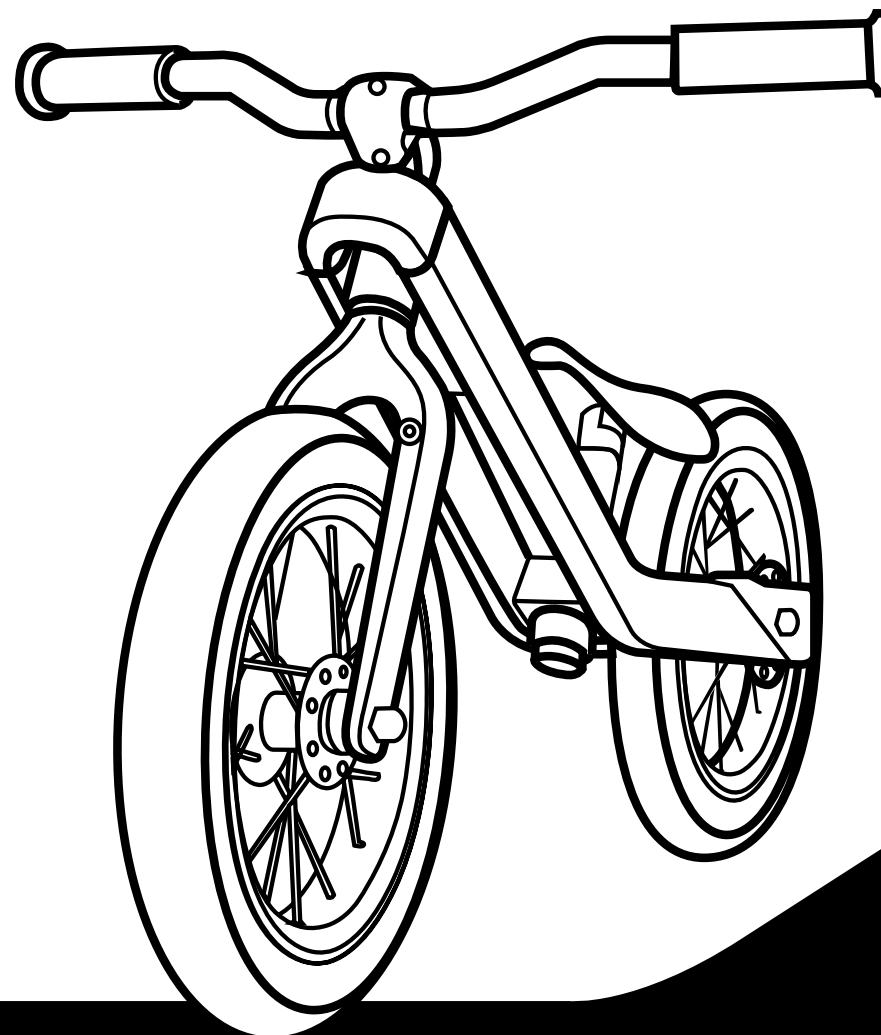
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INTRODUCTION

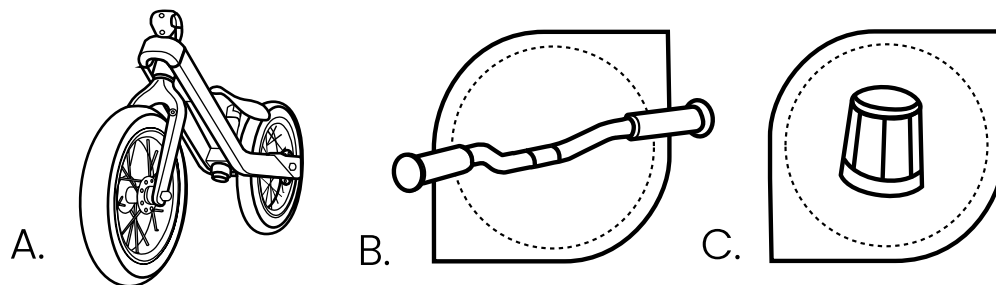
Thank you for purchasing a Vici balance bike.

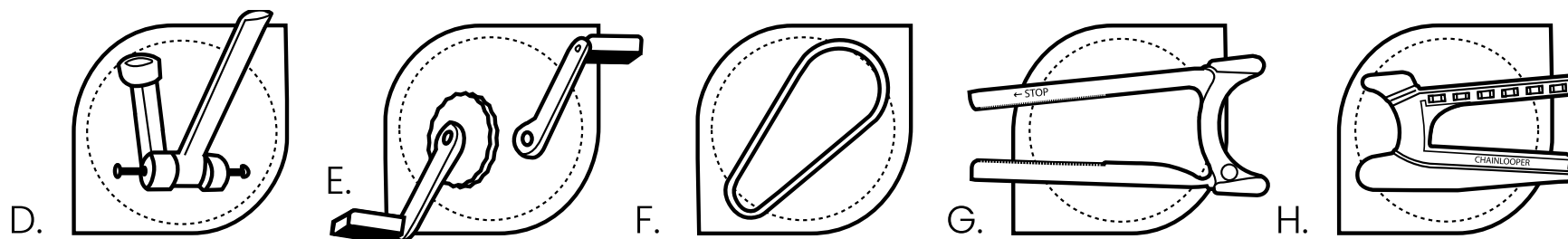

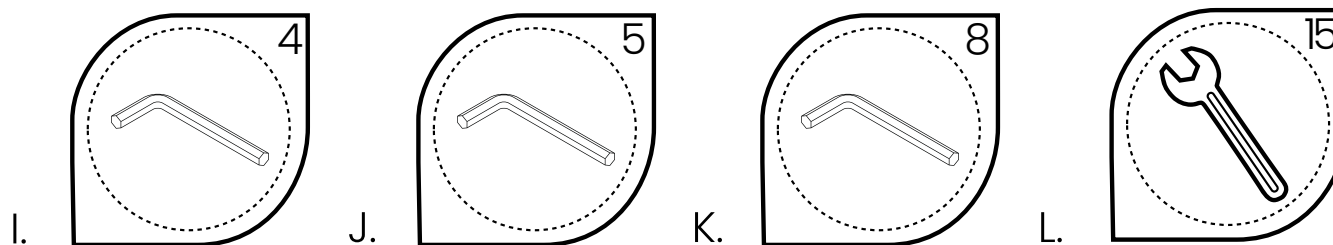

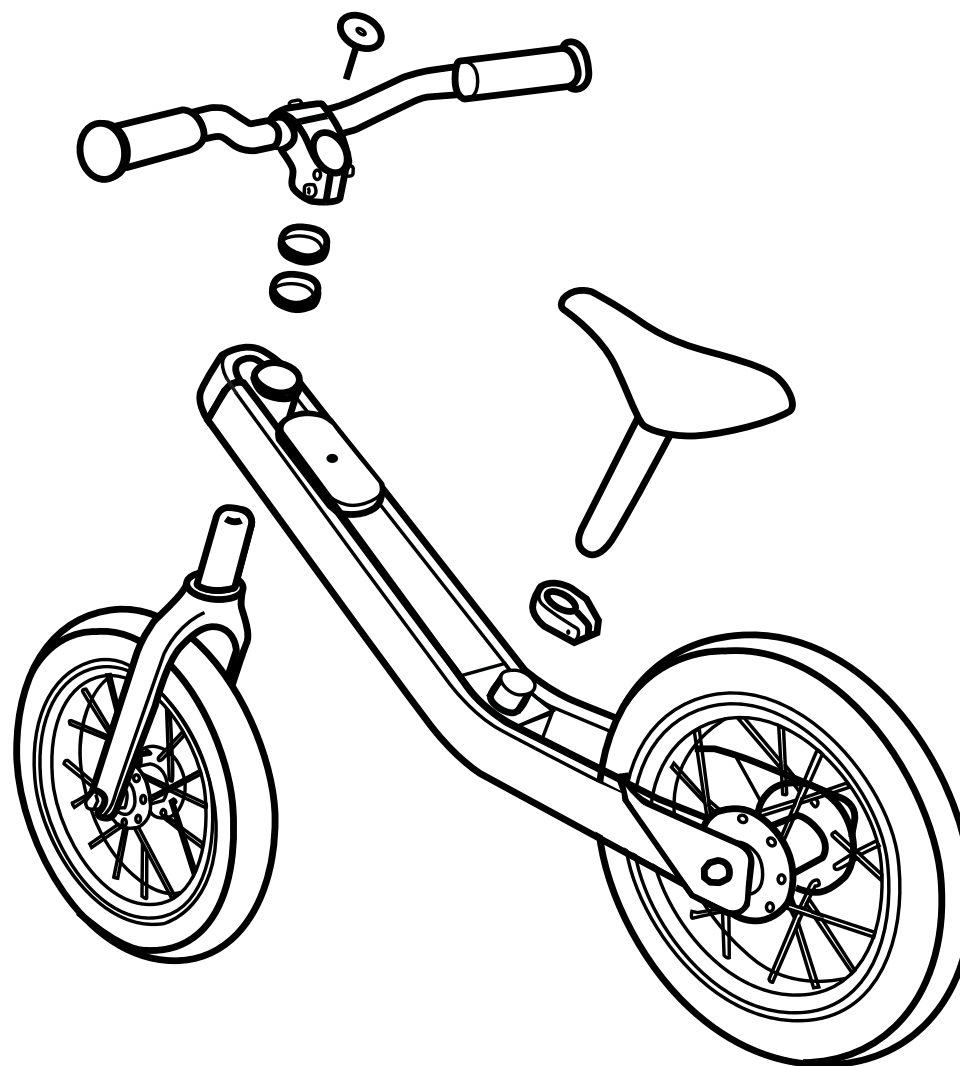


A. Vici frame

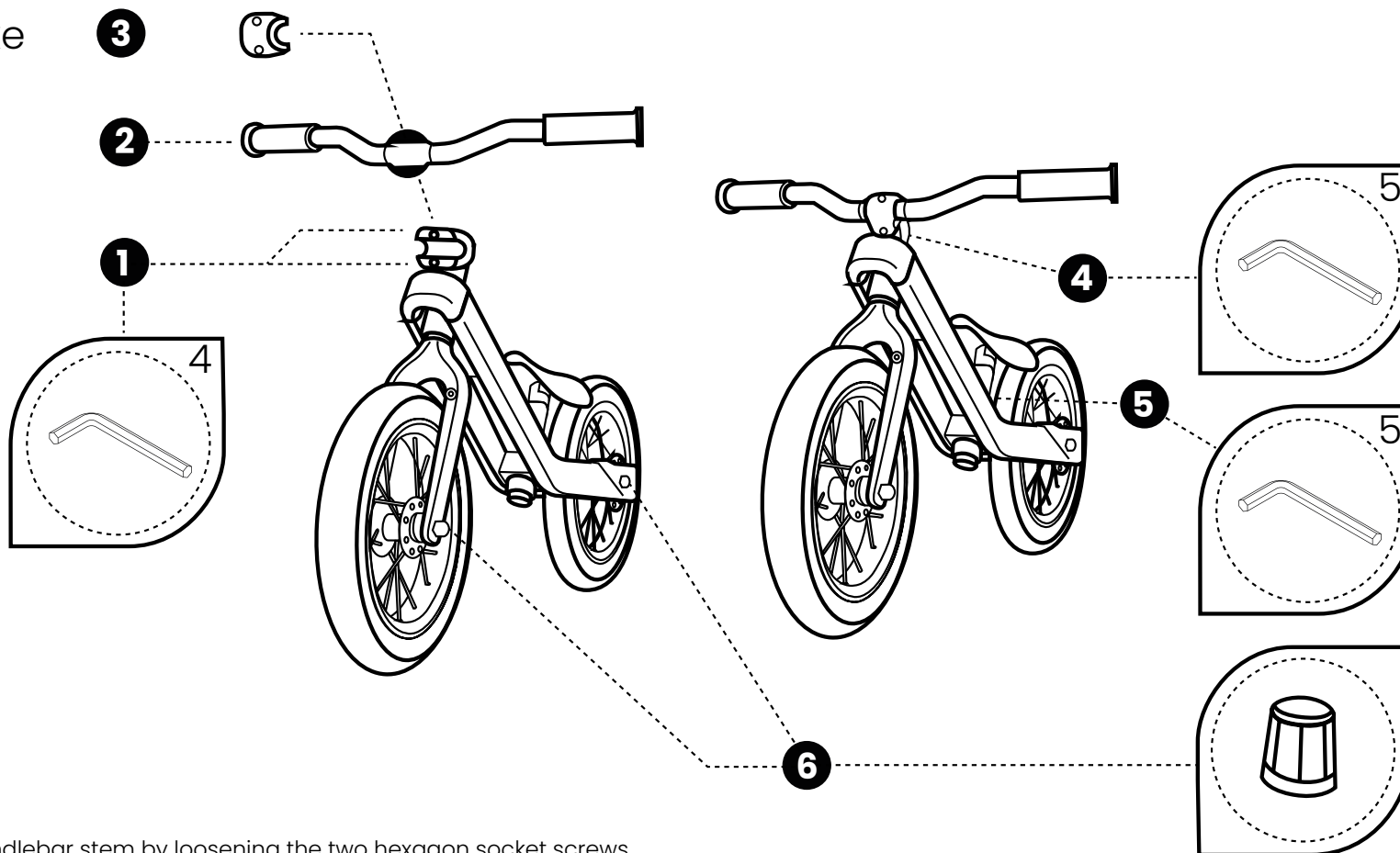

PHASE 1

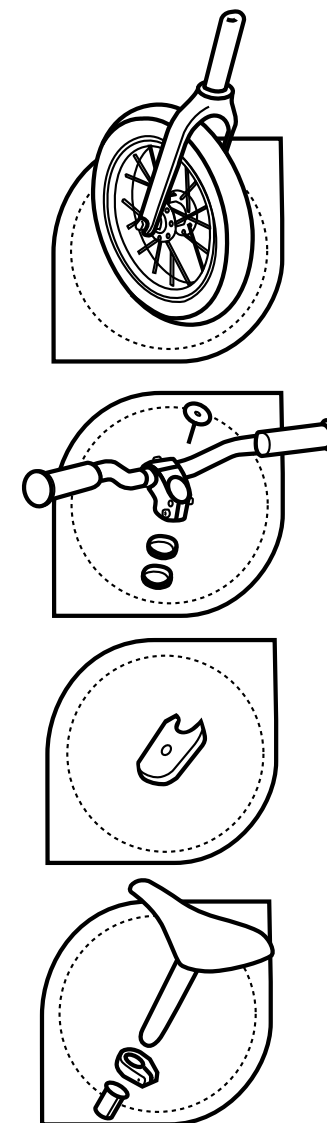
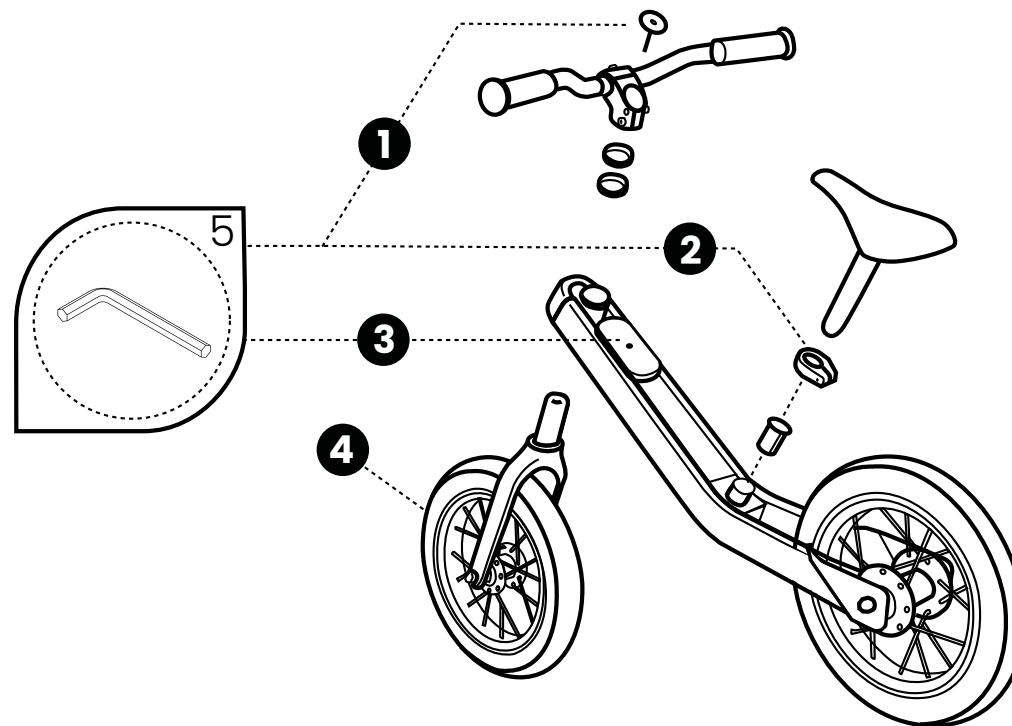
Low walking bike



- Step 1 Remove the handlebar stem by loosening the two hexagon socket screws.
- Step 2 Place the handlebars on the stem.
- Step 3 Place the mounting part back on the stem. Turn the handlebars into the correct position and tighten the two Allen screws.
- Step 4 Check that the handlebars are centred.
- Step 5 Adjust the saddle to the desired height for your child.
- Step 6 Attach the four protective caps supplied to the ends of the axles.

PHASE 2

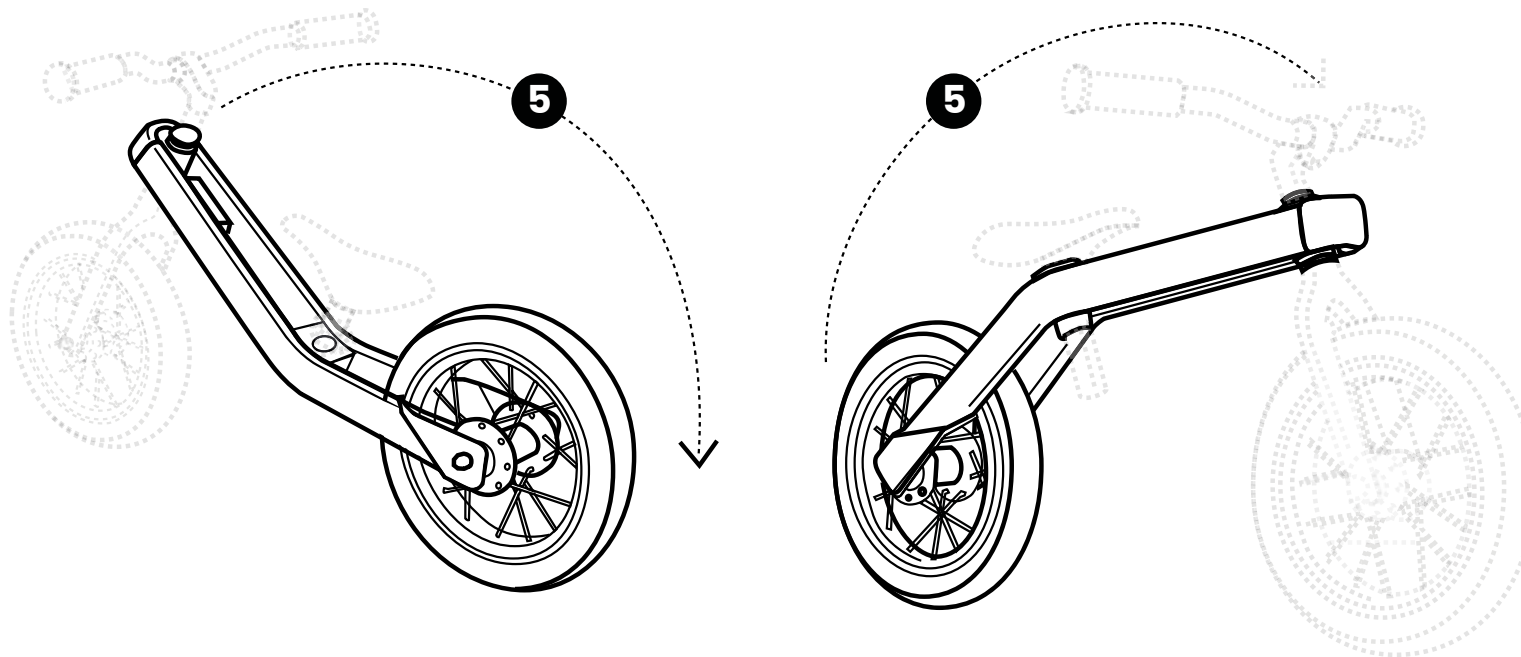
High balance bike



- Step 1 Loosen the Allen screws on the handlebars (top and side Allen screws) with the Allen key 5 until the handlebars can be removed. Remove the handlebars, washers and stem and set them aside.
- Step 2 Loosen the Allen screw of the saddle. Set the saddle aside and remove the saddle clamp and washer.
- Step 3 Remove the plastic cover by loosening the Allen screw.
- Step 4 Lift the frame and remove the front fork and wheel at once.

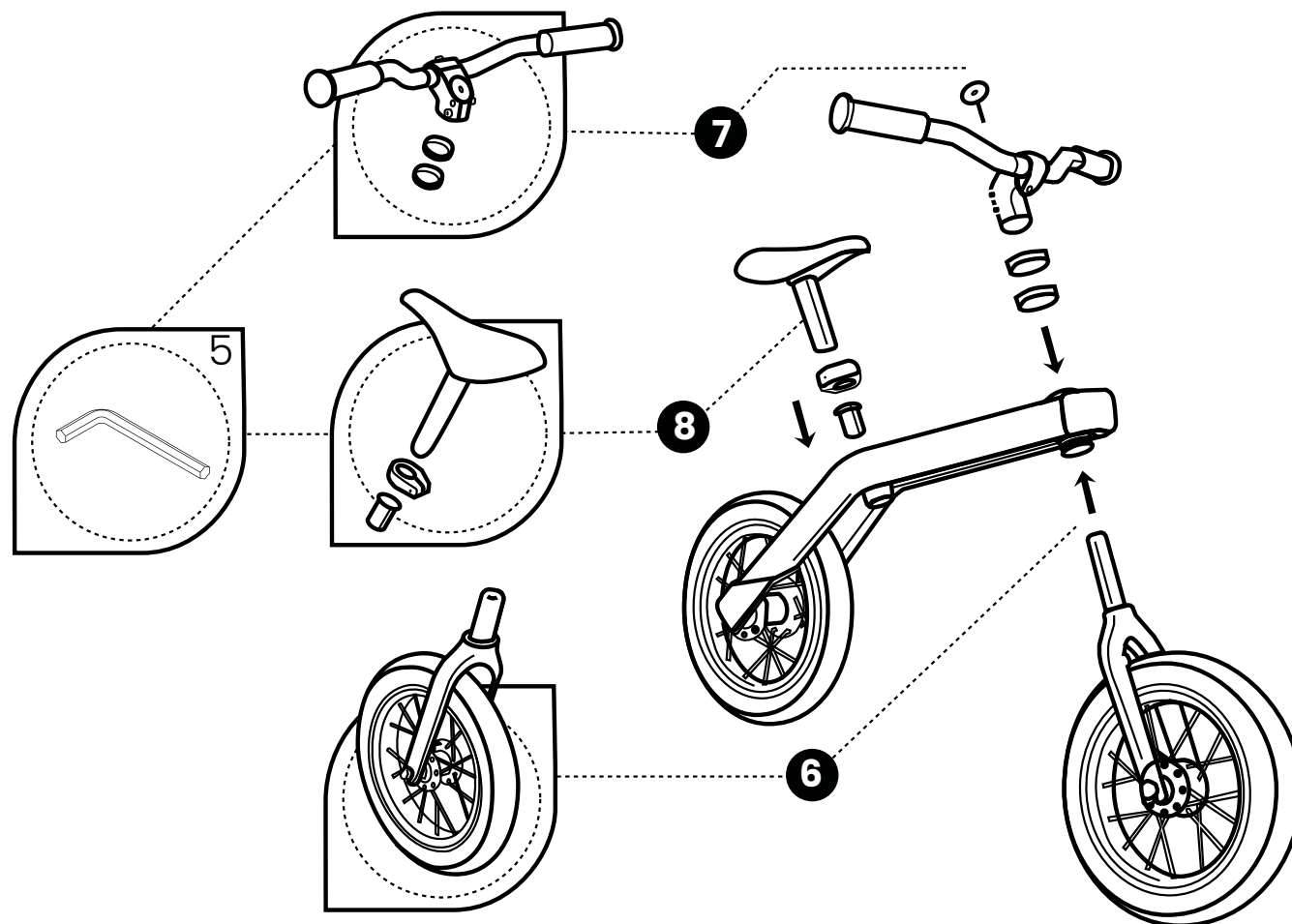

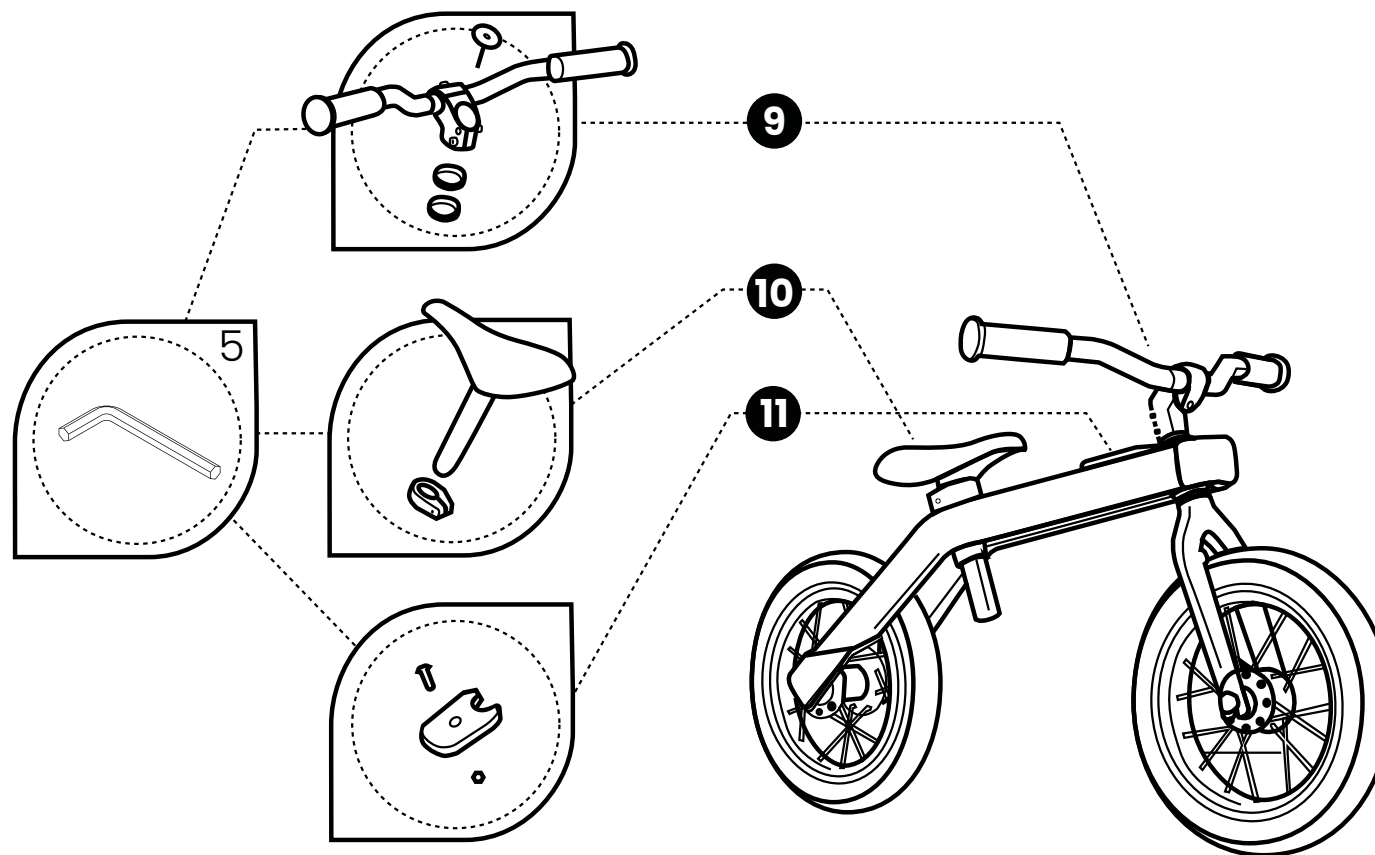

- Step 6 Put the front fork with the wheel back into the bike.
- Step 7 Place the handlebars on the fork and add the shims. First tighten the Allen screw above the stem.
The tighter this screw is tightened, the easier it will be to move the handlebars back and forth and vice versa.
- Step 8 Place the shim and the seat clamp on the frame and slide the seat post into the seat tube.

- Step 9 Align the handlebars and tighten the Allen screws on the side of the stem.
- Step 10 Tighten the Allen screws of the saddle until the saddle stays in place on its own.
Adjust the saddle to the correct height and tighten the Allen screws securely.
- Step 11 Reattach the plastic part to the same position on the frame.

PHASE 3

Pedal bike



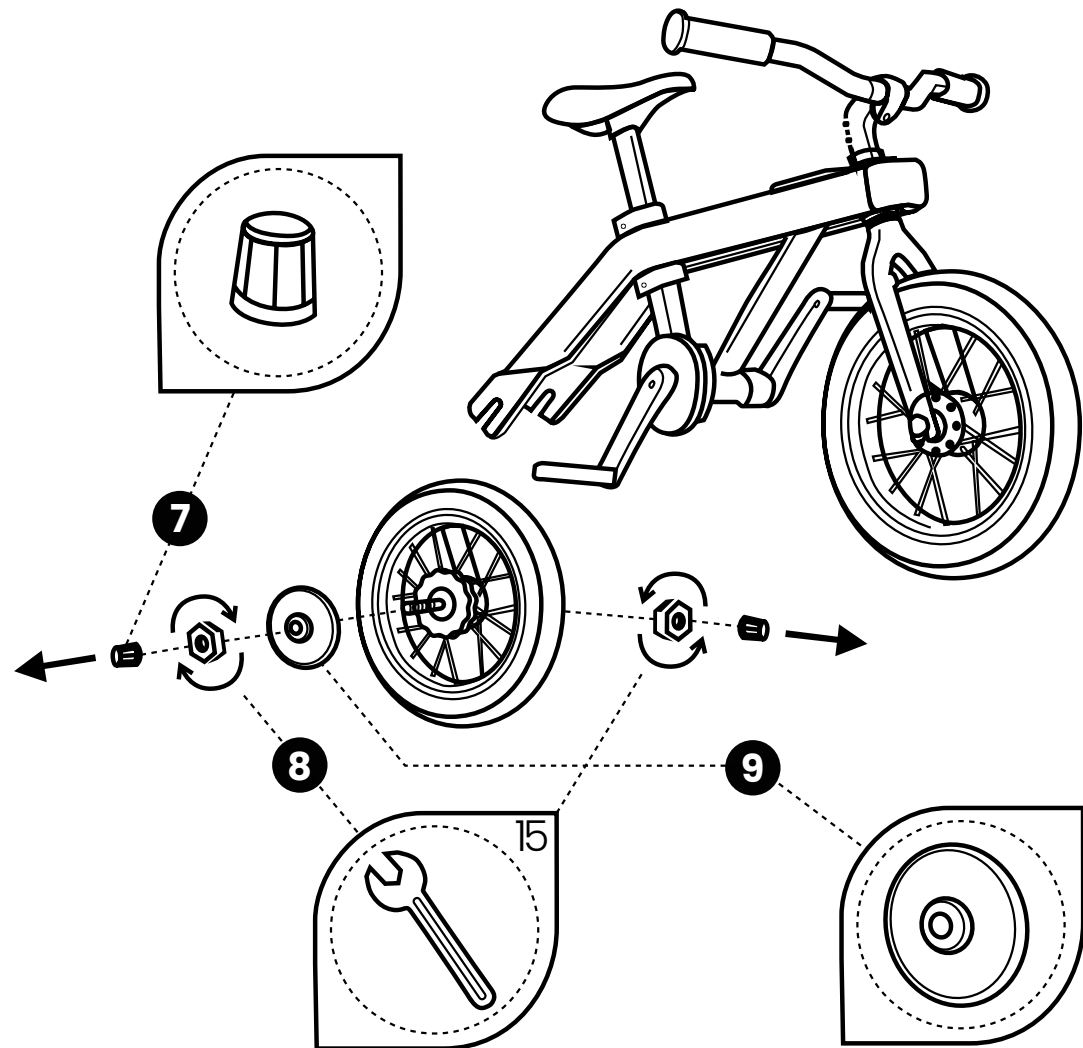
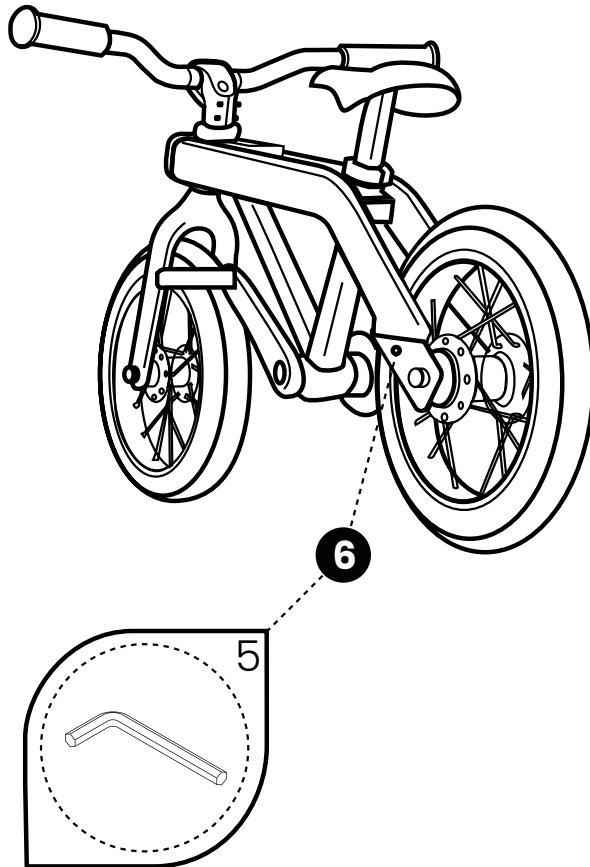
- Step 1 Remove the plastic part.
- Step 2 Slide the pedal frame over the seat tube from below.
- Step 3 Replace the plastic part and tighten the Allen screw on the front of the frame.
- Step 4 Tighten the Allen screws at the rear of the frame.

- Step 5 Remove the bottom bracket bolts using the Allen key. Fit the pedals with the bottom bracket bolt.

Note: Position the pedal with sprocket on the same side as the sprocket on the rear axle.

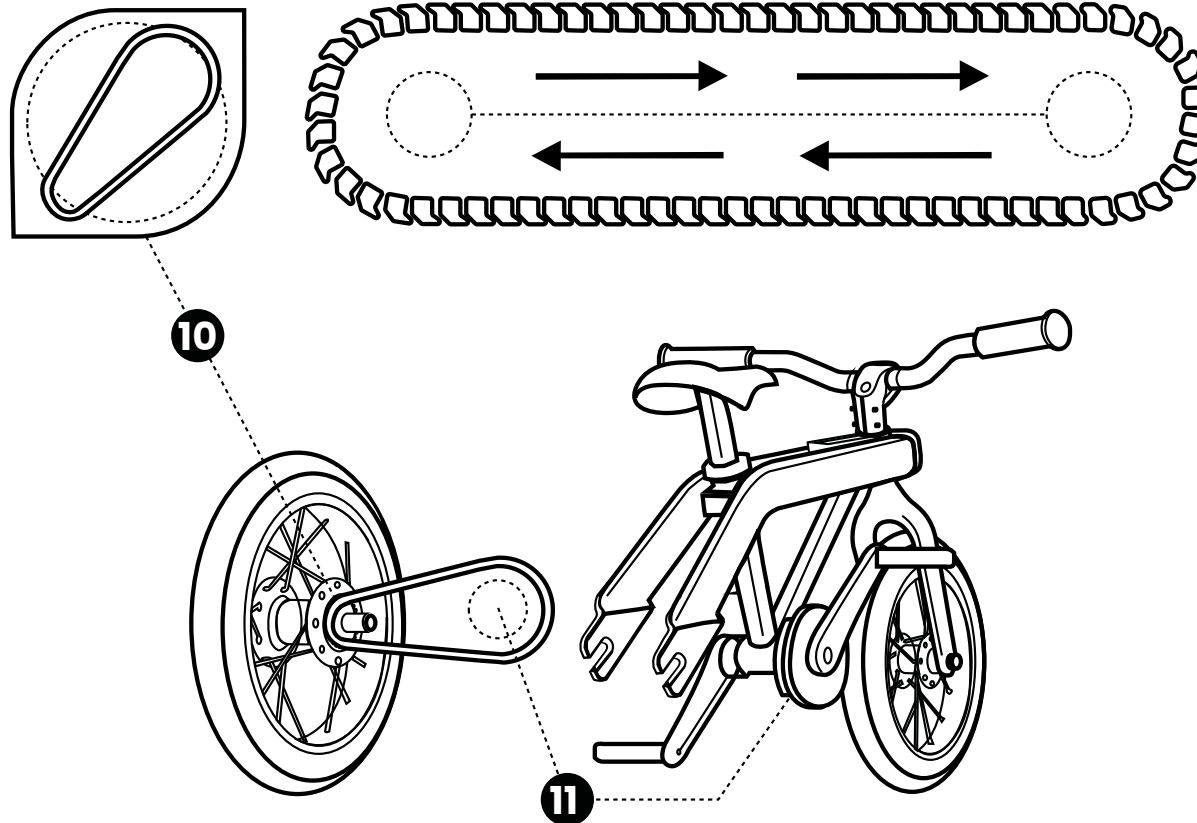

- Step 6 Release the reversing brake.
- Step 7 Remove the protective caps from the rear axle.
- Step 8 Loosen the rear axle nuts with the spanner until they are loose enough to remove from the rear fork.
- Step 9 Remove the protective cap from the rear axle sprocket.

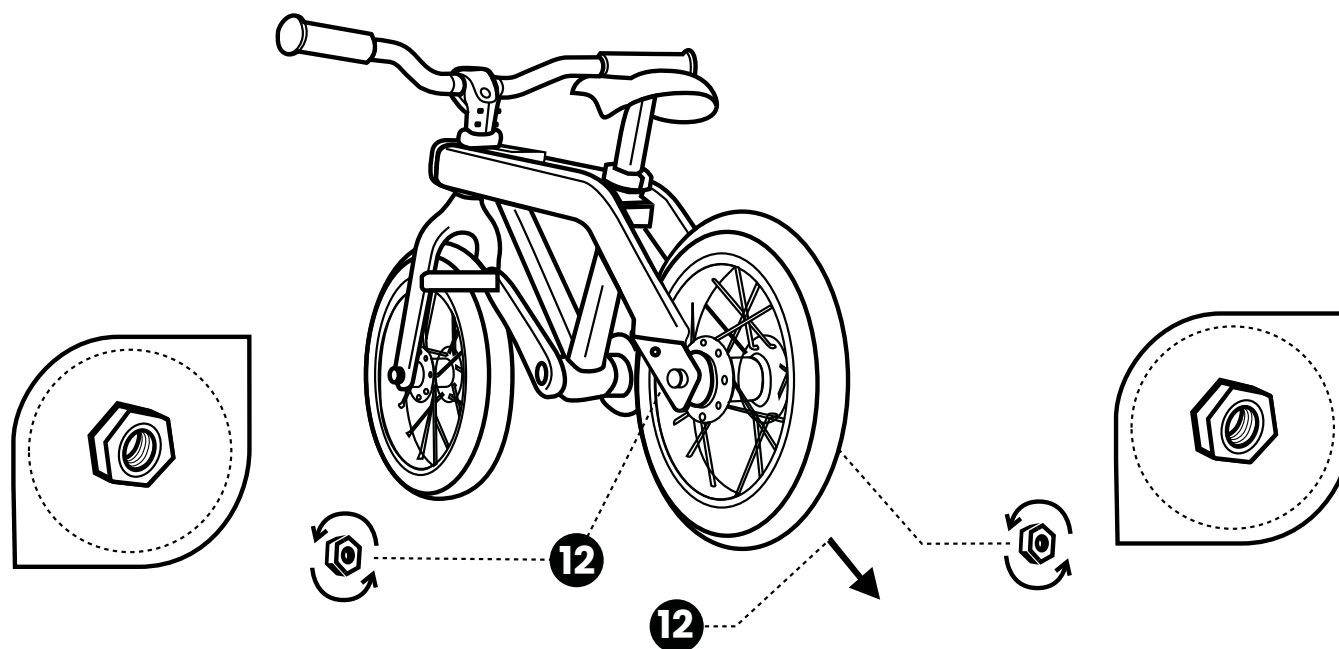
Pedal bike



- Step 10 Place the chain around the rear axle on the sprocket.
Step 11 Place the rear axle in the frame and place the chain over the front sprocket.

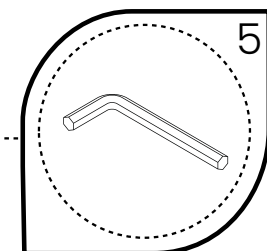
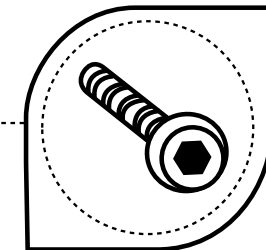
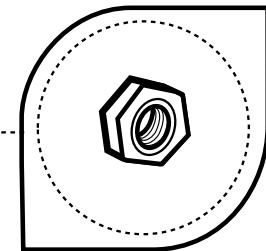
Step 12 Tension the chain by pulling on the rear wheel and loosely tighten the nuts by hand.

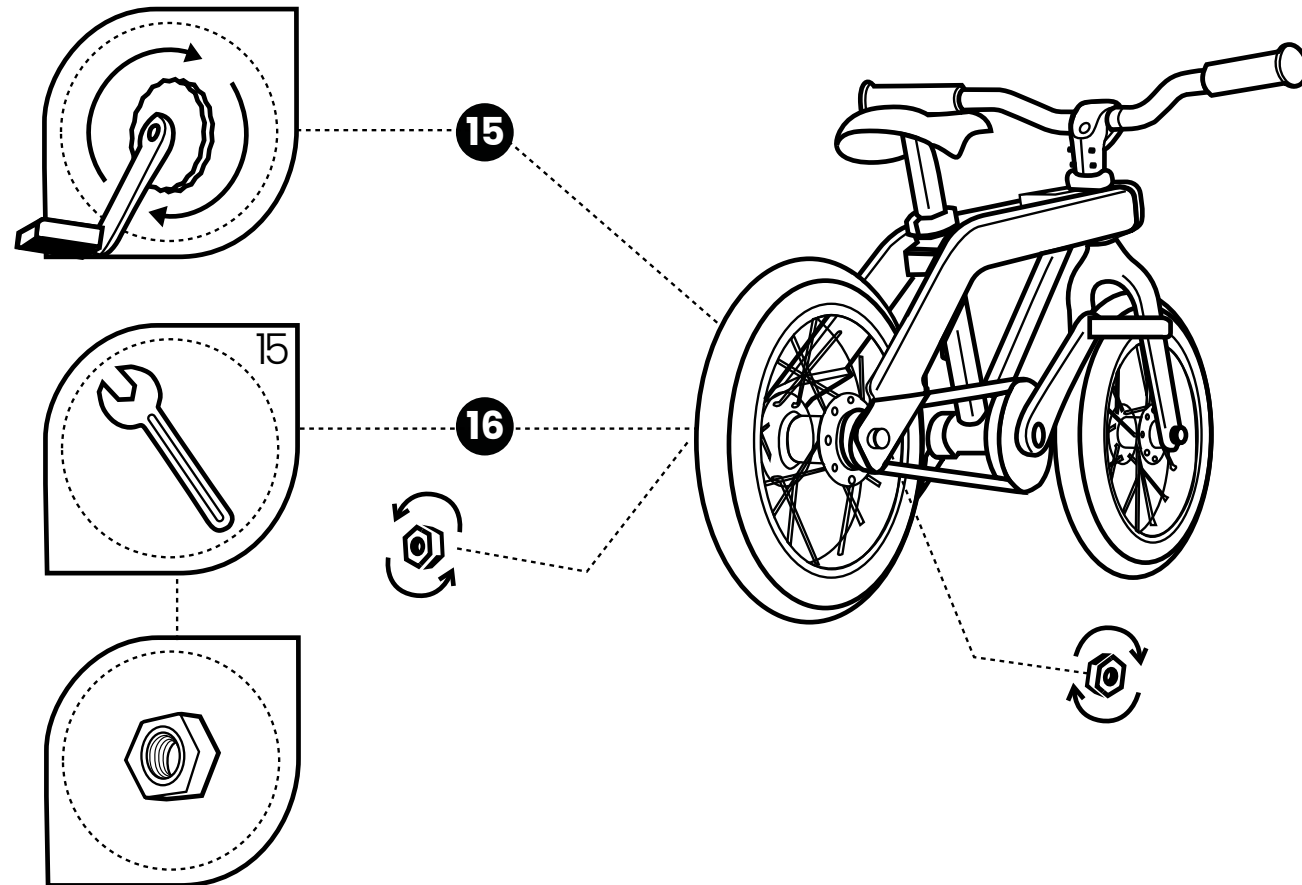

Step 13 Refit the reverse brake to the frame.

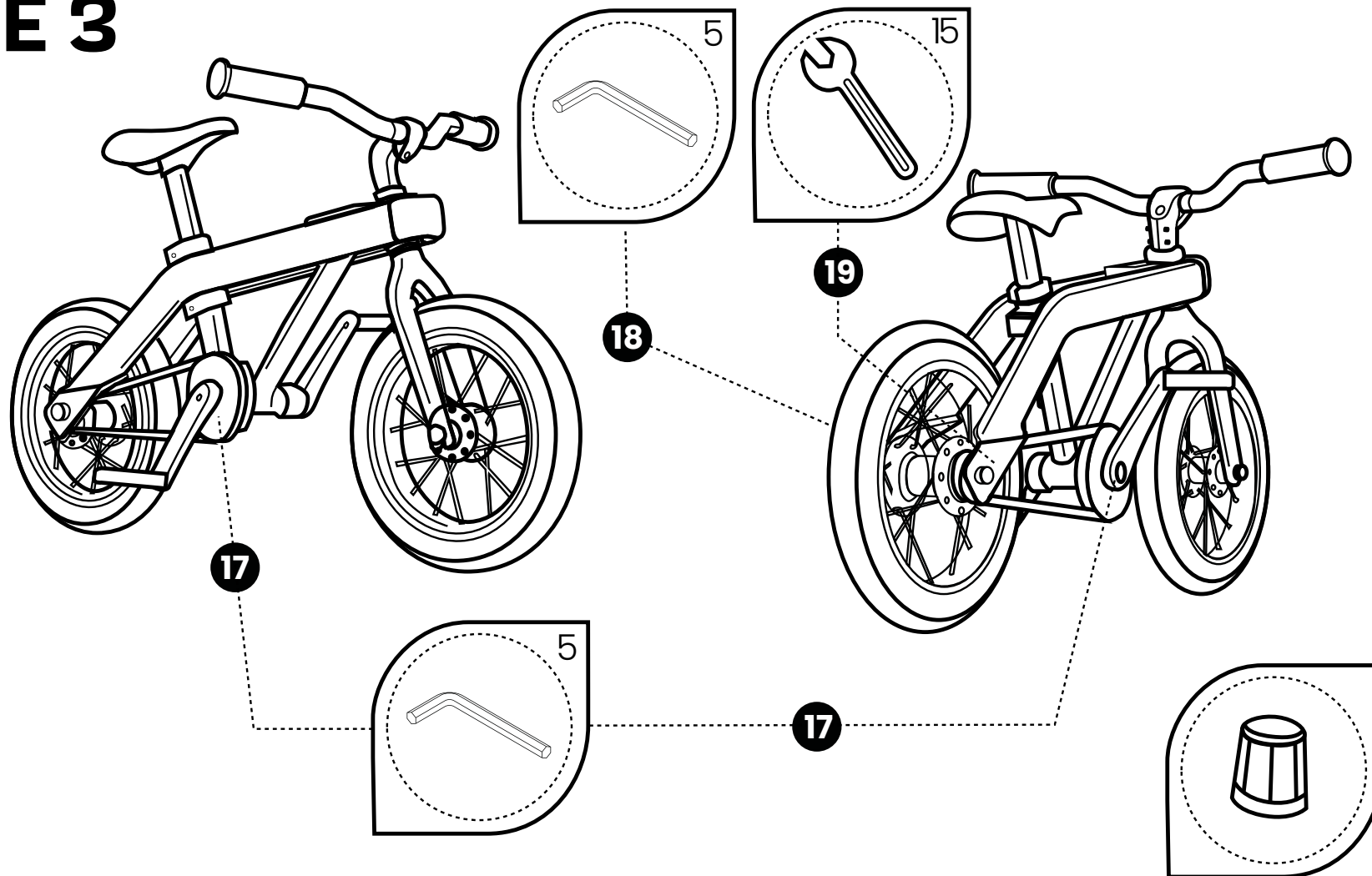


Step 15 Turn the bicycle upside down, resting it on the saddle and handlebars. Reattach the coaster brake to the frame.

Step 16 When the wheel is straight and the chain is tight, tighten the nuts with a wrench.

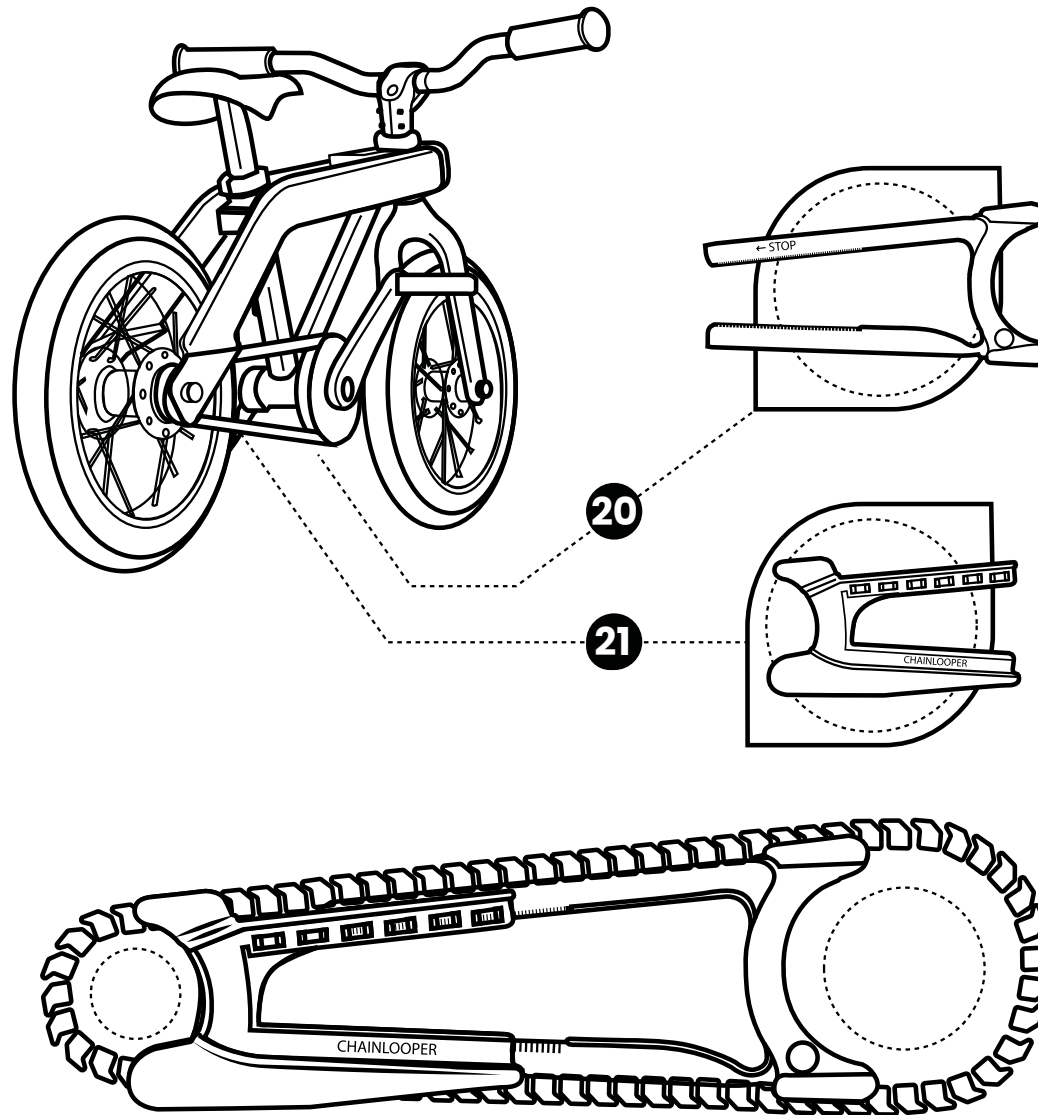
Step 17 Check both cranks and pedals for tightness.

Step 18 Check the function of the coaster brake.

Step 19 Check that both rear axle bolts are tight and place the protective caps on the rear axle.
The last step is to fit the inner protective caps of the chain

Chain guard

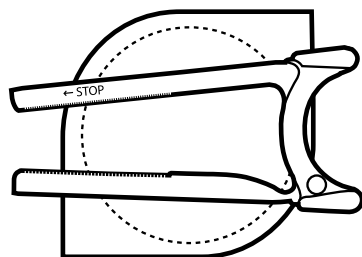


The final step is to install the inner protective caps of the chain.

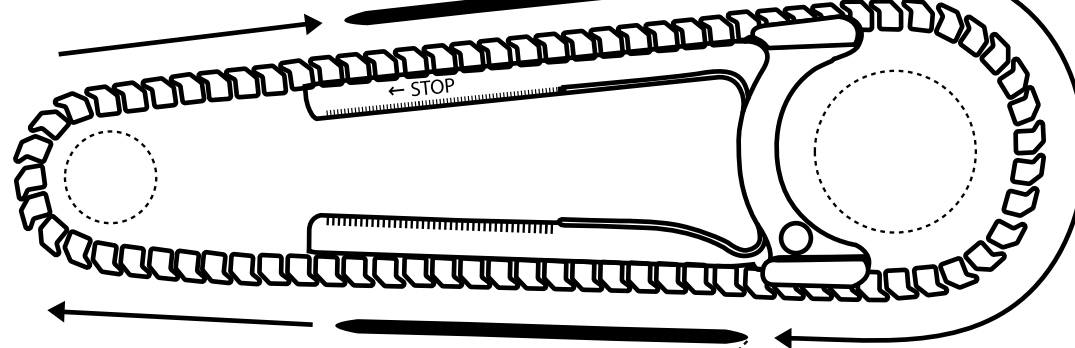

Direction of rotation

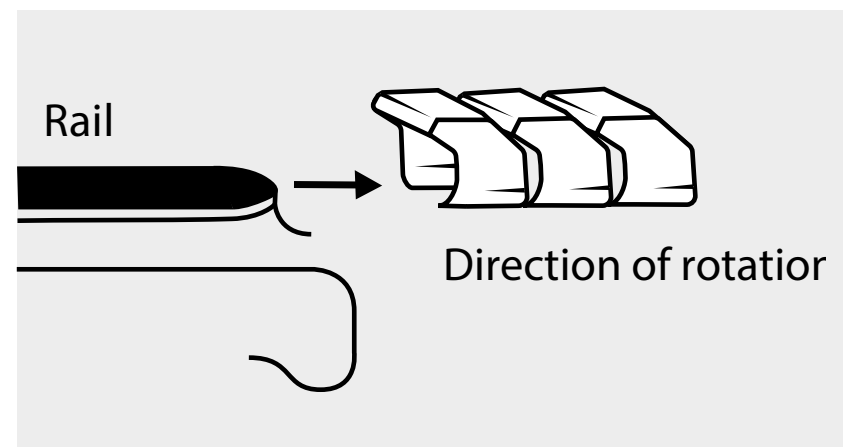
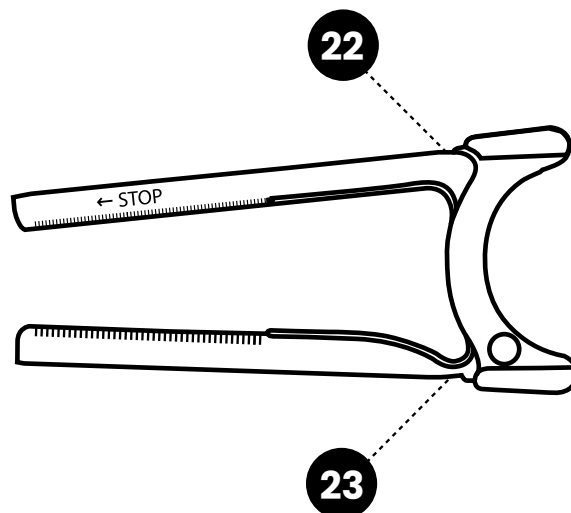

- Step 22 Place the front part of the protector between the chain and push it a little into the chain. By holding the protector and turning the pedals, the entire chain slides into the chain. Move it until the top rail has completely disappeared and is mounted on the chain.
- Step 23 Repeat this process for the bottom bar.

PHASE 3

Chain guard

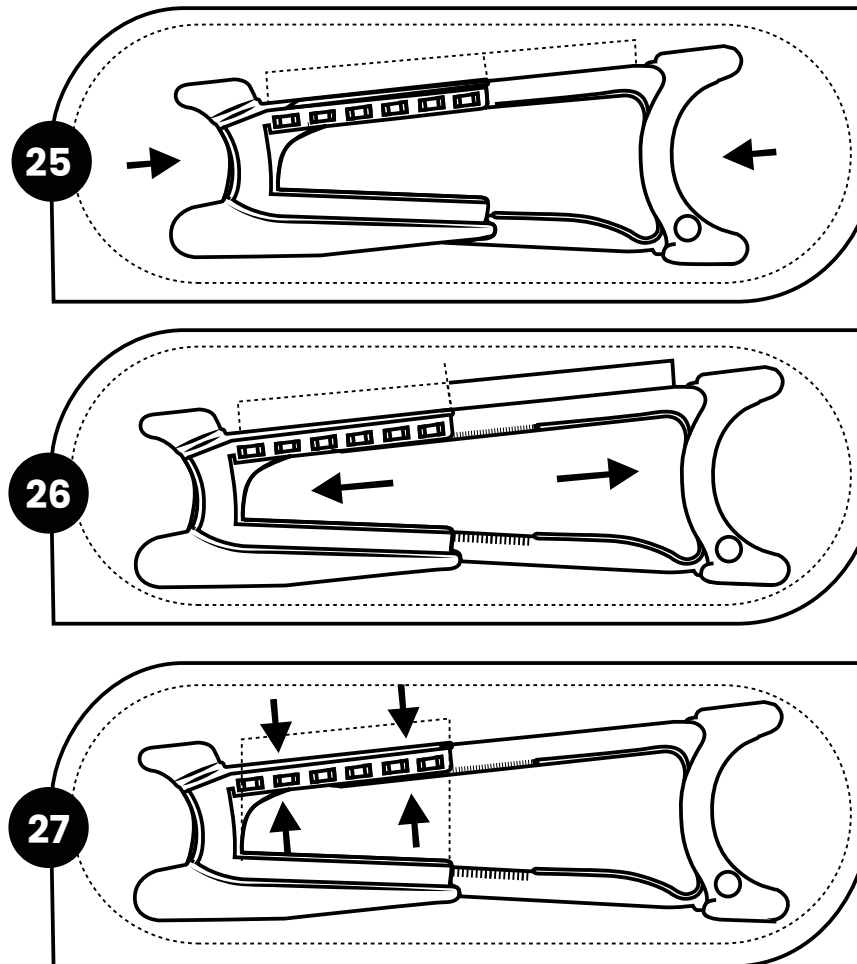


Step 24 Place the chain guard D.2 between the chain. Make sure that the top and bottom of D.1 are in the grooves of D.2.

Note: Place the hook from 24 between the chain and try to turn the chain. Then go to step 25.

PHASE 3

Chain guard



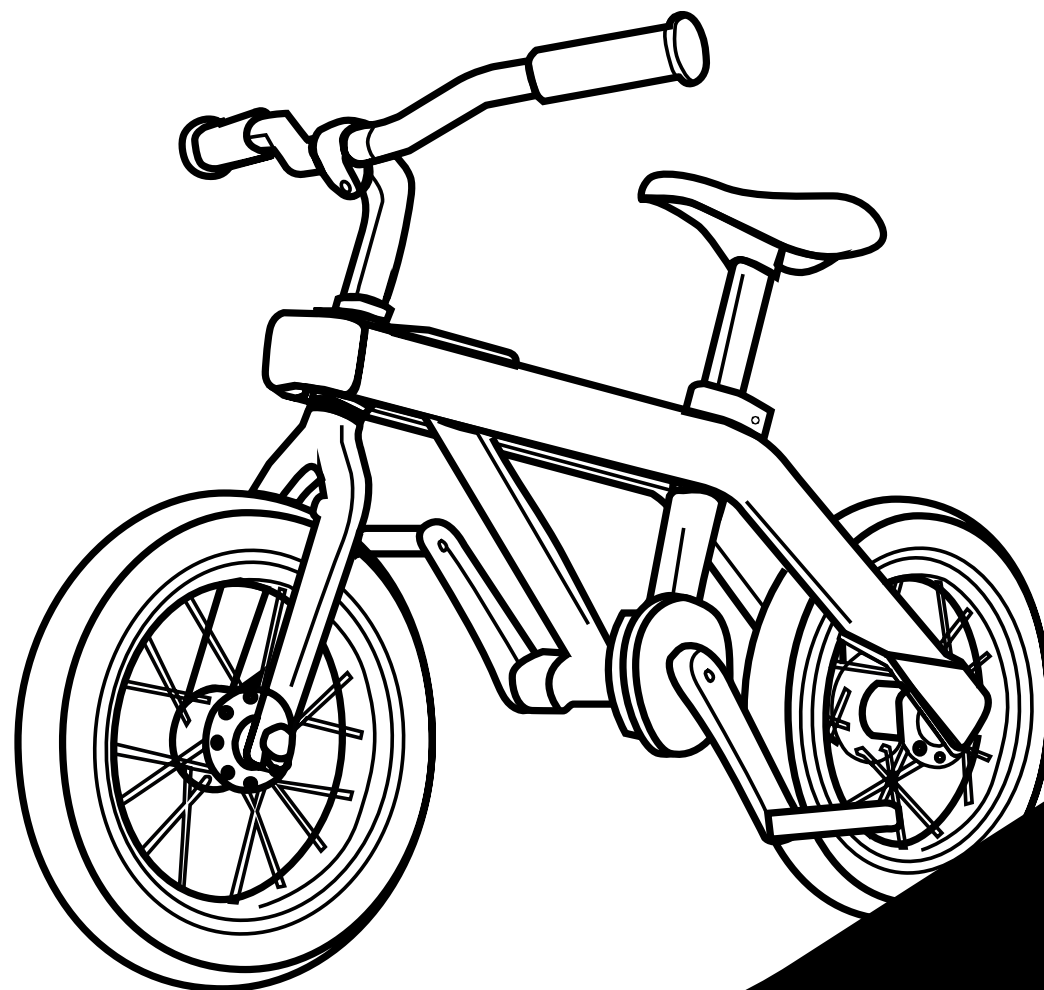
- Step 25 Check that the rails and the 'hook 24' guide the chain smoothly.
- Step 26 Adjust the chain guard by sliding the two elements apart until the chain is completely covered.
- Step 27 When the chain is tight and covered, the rear part can be clicked into place at the top.

SAFETY

- Cycle in a safe environment, free from traffic and dangerous terrain
